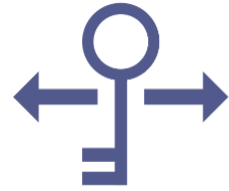

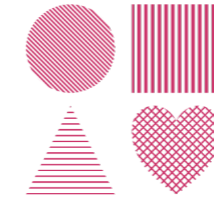
Local focus building into citywide collaboration
